

Here's a knitting pattern for the middle toy, a female sailor. This pattern will guide you through creating the legs, skirt, torso, arms, head, and sailor cap.

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## Materials

- **Yarn:** Navy blue, light blue, white, flesh-tone, and brown.
- **Knitting Needles:** 2.5mm or 3mm needles, depending on yarn thickness.
- **Polyester stuffing:** For filling the toy.
- **Embroidery thread:** Black for eyes, and red for mouth.
- **Tapestry Needle:** For stitching and embroidery.
- **Optional:** Small buttons for uniform details.

## Techniques

- **Stocking Stitch (St st):** Knit one row, purl one row.
  - **Garter Stitch:** Knit every row.
  - **Increasing and Decreasing:** For shaping parts.
  - **Embroidery:** For facial features and uniform details.
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## Knitting Pattern Instructions

### 1. Legs and Shoes (Make 2)

1. **With brown yarn,** cast on 8 stitches.
2. **Knit in St st** for 6 rows to create the shoes.
3. **Switch to white yarn** and knit for 14 rows to form the legs.
4. Bind off and set aside. Repeat for the second leg.

### 2. Skirt

1. **With navy blue yarn,** cast on 18 stitches.
2. **Knit in St st** for 12 rows for the skirt.
3. Bind off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### 3. Torso

1. **With light blue yarn,** cast on 18 stitches.
2. **Knit in St st** for 10 rows to form the lower torso.
3. **Switch to navy blue yarn** and knit 4 rows for the belt area.
4. Continue with light blue yarn for another 8 rows to finish the upper torso.

5. Bind off, leaving a long tail.

#### 4. Arms (Make 2)

1. **With light blue yarn**, cast on 6 stitches.
2. **Knit in St st** for 10 rows for the arms.
3. **Switch to flesh-tone yarn** and knit 4 rows to create the hands.
4. Bind off and set aside. Repeat for the second arm.

#### 5. Head

1. **With flesh-tone yarn**, cast on 12 stitches.
2. **Knit in St st**, increasing by 1 stitch at each end of every alternate row until you have 18 stitches.
3. **Knit straight** for 12 rows to form the round head.
4. Start decreasing by 1 stitch at each end of every alternate row until you return to 12 stitches.
5. Bind off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

#### 6. Sailor Cap

1. **Using white yarn**, cast on 20 stitches.
2. **Knit 4 rows in garter stitch** for the brim.
3. **Knit in St st** for 6 rows.
4. Start decreasing by 2 stitches every row until you have 8 stitches left.
5. Bind off, leaving a long tail. Sew into a circular shape and attach to the head.

#### 7. Hair

1. **Using brown yarn**, cast on 14 stitches.
2. **Knit in St st** for 6 rows to form a strip of hair.
3. Bind off and sew it around the top of the head, under the cap.

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#### Assembly

1. **Stuff each piece** with polyester filling for firmness.
2. Sew the legs to the bottom of the skirt.
3. Attach the torso to the top of the skirt.
4. Sew the arms to each side of the torso.
5. Attach the head on top of the torso.
6. Position and sew the cap onto the head.

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### **Finishing Touches**

1. **Embroidery:** Use black thread to add the eyes and red thread for a small smile.
2. **Buttons:** Add tiny buttons or embroidery details down the front of the torso as uniform accents.
